

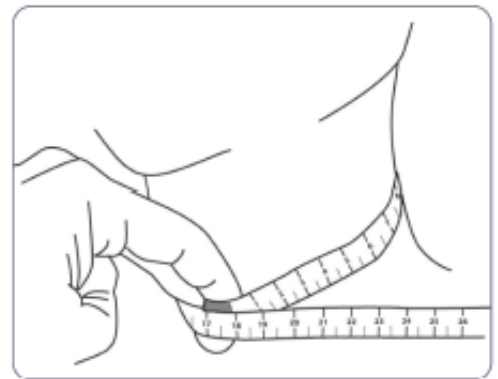

Necklace Sizing Guide

Procedure to measure necklace size:

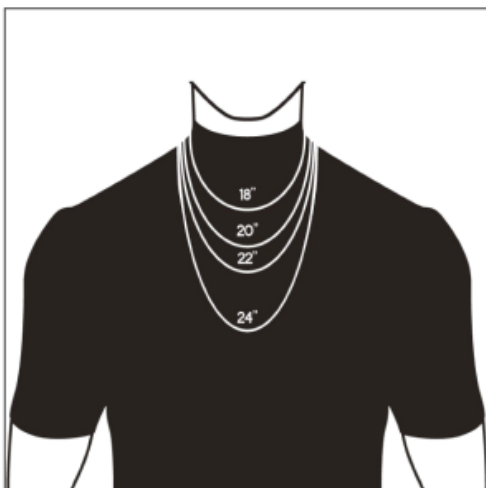
To ensure you can adorn your new necklace you'll want it to be the correct size. Measuring a necklace length is very easy. We suggest finding a necklace you already own that is the size you wish your new piece to be.

- Step 1: Unclasp this necklace.
- Step 2: Lay it out flat next to a ruler or measuring tape.
- Step 3: Note it's measurement in inches or centimeters.
- Step 4: This will give you the length that you should be looking for when buying a new chain.



Don't worry if you do not have a necklace at home, measure your neck size. Neck size is probably the most important measurement for determining which necklace length will work best for you. To measure, wrap a soft tape measure around your neck, keeping the tape measure parallel to the floor as you measure. Then, add 2 to 4 inches (5 to 10 cm) to your neck measurement to calculate your minimum recommended chain length.

Men's Standard Necklace Sizes:

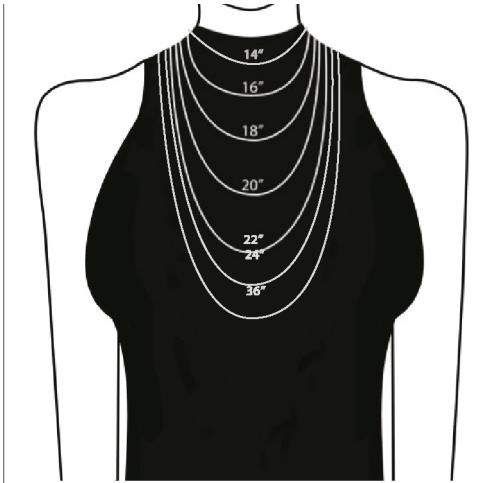


Length	Placement
18"	Falls just around the base of the neck.
20"	Falls right at the collarbone.
22"	Falls few inches below the collarbone.
24"	Falls just above the sternum.

Women's Standard Necklace Sizes:



Length	Placement
14"	Tightly around the neck.
16"	Around the base of the neck like a collar.
18"	Below the throat at the collarbone.
20"	Few inches below the collarbone.
22"	Falls at or above a low neckline.
24"	Falls below any neckline.
36"	Hangs below the bosom.
